Tryouts for Spring 2010 Season

- If a player is medically unable to tryout, coaches for the top two teams must use one of their 'wild card' picks to choose that player.
- U12 coaches will be allowed 3 'wild card' picks, and U14 coaches will be allowed 4 'wild card' picks. A coach may only use a wild card to pull a player up one level. (i.e.—a player slated to the third team may only be pulled up to the second team)
- The teams will be formed using the Independent evaluations, along with input from the EB coaches. EB coaches did NOT evaluate their own children.
- It is EBYSA's intention to fully roster all teams at this time, wherever possible. If there are sufficient numbers in an age group, the teams will be fully rostered. We understand that circumstances may arise that result in players deciding not to participate in travel soccer for the 2010 spring season. The tryout evaluators will designate 2 alternates on each second and third team. If a space opens up on a higher level team, that coach has the ability to ask the 1st alternate to move up and join their team.
- Alternates to have the right to decline the move up, at which time the 2nd alternate will be asked.
- EBYSA will freeze all rosters for the purposes of moving alternates 2 weeks prior to the start of the South Shore League season.
- Rosters will NOT be posted until ALL teams are formed, and until any players who may not have been placed on a team have been notified.
- Coaches will not make any communication to their prospective teams until after the rosters have been posted to the EBYSA website.
- Once all non-placed players have been contacted, an email will be sent to all coaches, giving them the OK to contact their teams.
